In Your Room

Red – 2003 Chateau Tour Prignac Bordeaux
There's just nothing like a good French red Bordeaux.
Earthy with dark fruit and raisins wrapped around subtle
suggestions of chocolate and tobacco.

White – 2006 Voga Pinot Grigio
Okay, we admit it, we're suckers for the design even if it's a
wine bottle! And with this Pinot from Italy, you get great taste
AND cool design. It's very smooth, clear & clean.

Sparkling - Mumm Napa "Cuvee M" or "Brut Prestige"
A great balance of fizzy, bubbly fun with a clear, clean, fresh taste.
We picked the "Cuvee M" because, quite frankly,
we also love the cobalt blue label.

White—2005 Chateau du Cleary Sauvignon Blanc
A bigger finish than the Voga Pinot. Good if you like big!

Red - 1997-2004 M. Cosentino Ol' Red Blend
A Merlot, Cabernet, Pino Noir blend. Another big one!

Sparkling - 2005 Francis Coppola "Sofia" Blanc de Blanc
Francis Ford made this for his daughter, Sofia.

Sparkling—Voga Sparkling Pinot
Sparkling Pinot Grigio? Yes! One of the only ones in the US.

If you open a bottle, the cost will be added to your
room charge. Remember you must be 21 years old or
older to partake! Bottle of White or Red = \$25,
Bottle of Sparkling = \$25, Split of Sparkling = \$10,
Wine by the glass (in the office) = \$6.00
